





The Whakapapa ski area – known as the magic mountain – is only a 30 minute drive away from Turangi and many use Turangi as their base before heading to these famous slopes. In the evening Turangi is a mist of hot pools as mountain dwellers head back to sooth their muscles.

SOUTH ISLAND

New Zealand's South Island is the larger of the two and home to Christchurch – The Garden City – which shows just how much emphasis is placed on the beauty and natural preservation of the island.
