Each unit comes with a kitchen equipped with a stove, refrigerator and microwave. Guests also have access to an on-site hot spring and a restaurant as well as other onsite facilities in the main building. The resort is a 10-minute drive from JR Izukogen Train station, and a free shuttle bus service is offered for guests.

Neo-Oriental Resort Yatsugatakekogen is situated in the Yatsugatake area of Yamanashi Prefecture. Yamanashi is widely known as one of the most preferred residential areas in the country, and its harvest of grapes, peaches and plums is considered some of the best and most beautiful in Japan. Each unit is a private cottage surrounded by plenty of nature, offering a relaxing environment. The area boasts a variety of activities throughout a year such as hiking, fruit picking, visiting museums and winter sports. There is a hot spring, a restaurant, a souvenir shop, a spa and a catering service on site. A free shuttle is available from JR Kobuchizawa Train Station, which is a 20-minute drive away.

Located in Azumino, Nagano Prefecture, <u>Hotel Ambient Azumino</u> overlooks the beautiful landscape of the Japanese Alps, providing hotel guests a spectacular view that changes each season. Each spacious unit comes with a kitchen and a Japanese tatami room that allows extra guests to sleep on futon mattresses. There is a Japanese restaurant and a French restaurant in the hotel that offer flavorful dishes using fresh local ingredients. Several tourist attractions are located within a 30-minute drive from the resort, such as the Azumino National Park, Hotaka Shrine and Hotaka River. JR Hakuyacho Train Station is a 20-minute drive from the resort.
