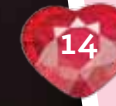

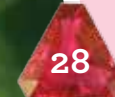

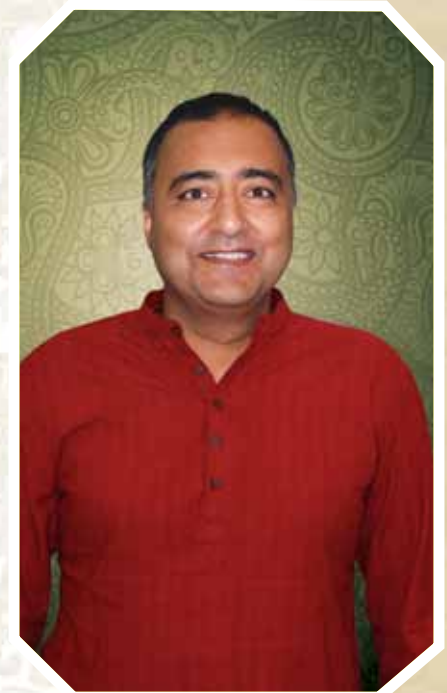

Across the western flank of India, a flash of brilliant gold undulates for miles into the clear blue of an equally shimmering horizon. Glittering with vibrant colours, vivacious culture and incredible Rajput lore, Rajasthan brings the overwhelming opulence of a past heritage into each living day, with generous grace and definitive dignity. A dreamland of unimaginable contrasts, this royal overload, stuns again, on the eastern side of the ancient Aravallis, with the green grandeur of lush forests and astonishing hilly escapes.

All you need to do, is dream. That you will live the dream, is an RCI word of honour.

The 15th century reservoir that supplied water to all of Jaisalmer, was built just outside the city. It is now known as the **Gadsisar Lake** and is a must-see.



As far as the eye can see, **Jaisalmer** extends like an endless sheath of precious glimmer below, reflecting the intense sunshine radiating from above. A picture-book vision to behold, the rough aridness and wrinkled sandy spectacle we revere as the great Thar encases in its golden frame, a sand city of exquisite yore. The shocking hostility of a seemingly dead landscape breaks free at every oasis, fresh and brilliant, like a studded finger ring set in exotic colours, fine artistry and uplifting music and dance. Honour stands stoic in every account of daunting loyalty of its queens and proud valour of its kings. Rich traditions and culture carry into the present day, undeterred. And the magic! Take a camel ride or go on a desert safari to discover the enigma of old forts and older relics, the contrasts of terrain and tale, and the warmth of traditional hospitality and aromatic cuisine, to ensure that your journey along these dunes is nothing short of an imperial fantasy in a grand, grand past.

Two hundred and fifty feet tall, the **Jaisalmer Fort**, lives on with a quarter of the old city's population still within its walls. The palace, the temples and quaint lanes packed with houses and handicraft shops, all stand as before, paved in stone. Beyond the fort walls, lie stunning views of the old city fading into the timeless desert. Enjoy the sunset views around the ramparts, under clear starry skies, to soak in the romance that exudes from this great land.





The nature trails of **Todgarh Raoli Wildlife Sanctuary** are spread over 500 sq km of land with an enchanting mosaic of rivers, valleys, dense forests and sandy plains beyond. The wildlife sanctuary has a wonderful variety of birds and a healthy leopard and sloth bear population. Either embark on a sensational jungle safari or trek to your heart's content along these sensational mountain trails.

Historical **Dewair** is the blessed site where Maharana Pratap defeated Akbar. Draw from the power of the land and enjoy the views around.

As rich and lavish as the deserts on the west, is the eastern lushness of Todgarh. Historical and prettily pronged on the Aravallis, this divine hill station sits 3,281 ft above sea level. A retreat from the flurry of Ajmer, this little nook of nature was discovered by the famous historian Colonel James Tod, during the colonial era and was built into a village with Victorian edifices and all amenities of the time. The house in which he stayed for 20 years and wrote his renowned work, 'Annals and Antiquities of Rajputana' from, has since been converted into a Jain monument, Pragma Shikhar.

Within the Bhagora forest block, **Bheelberi Falls** cascade from a staggering height of 55 m. Ornithologists can feast their eyes on roosting long-billed vultures, while the rest can revel along rejuvenating mountain slopes.



The charms of the hilly Aravalli forests against the scenic backdrop of its ranges were once the hunting grounds of the British. These luxuriant forests are now a protected wildlife sanctuary, home to delightful birds and a thriving number of great cats. Camp along its refreshing trekking trails and lose yourself in the calm of ancient rivers and valleys of the oldest mountain ranges in the world.

A cluster of little jewels in the heart of the rice bowl of Kerala, the Kuttanad region, is **Kumarakom**. Rich in its setting, its charm is further enhanced by the ethereal beauty of the Vembanad lake, the largest in the backwaters that off-set this fascinating village. Take a boat ride along the famed waterways and delve into the pastoral lives of its people, relish the gastronomic delights of their food and be enchanted by the richness of their unique culture. Ancient and mystic, Keralite festivities, martial arts and dance forms are matchless treats, not to be missed. Hailed as a must-do by the National Geographic Magazine, Kumarakom encapsulates the essence of a certain fulfilment, with rare panache.

Taking this magic into the realm of utter bliss, is **Poovar**, a natural wonder, where, rustic land holds by its fringes, the lithe poise of a lake, a river, a sea and its shore, in a balance so fine, even the Gods sigh in pride. The only route into this fishing village is via water, and even its name bears a fluid story. Marthanda Varma Maharaja, during his days of royal refuge, had described the Neyyar river as, *poo aar*, meaning 'stream of flowers', as he observed the vision of red Kovala flowers, paving the river like a necklace of crimson, across its emeraldine course down south. Enjoy a similar charisma along cruises into neighbouring villages and romance the arts or find new peace by the pristine beauty of its beach, where only gentle waves of the sea and the long calls of sea birds give you company. Surrounded by local flowers, countless spices and abundant coconut and banana groves, paradise does not get any better than this.

Once a rubber plantation, **Kumarakom Bird Sanctuary** is now a haven for birds like Indian fruit bats, purple moorhen, night herons, teals and egrets. Keep your camera on the ready.

The ancient town of **Kottayam** with its 700-year old churches are most famous for their paintings. More stunning art adorn the walls of Ettumanoor Siva Temple to the north. While there, also visit the fabled Thirunakkara Mahadeva Temple in the heart of town.

A few hours away is the capital city of **Thiruvananthapuram**. Pay a visit to its stunning temples, museums and beautiful zoological garden. The **Ponmudi** trekking trails by the Kallar river and lightly wooded slopes can be quite refreshing too.

Kanyakumari, at the southernmost tip of India, brings together the Bay of Bengal, the Indian Ocean and the Arabian Sea. It is a day out, you will cherish for long.

The flat grasslands of Kaziranga are home to some of the most exotic wildlife in the world. Rhino-spotting makes it that much more enticing.

United-21 Kaziranga



Book yourself a cottage for a vibrant, yet calming, holiday. Furnished with eco-friendly material, it offers comfortable accommodation and privacy. Located in the Kaziranga area in close proximity to the wildlife reserve, a UNESCO world heritage site, this dedicated wildlife and eco-tourism resort will ensure that you leave here with memories to last a lifetime.

Assam's *pièce de résistance*, its prized jewel, remains the Great Indian Rhinoceros. A show-stopper in the true sense, the one-horned rhino freely roams 430 sq km of diverse grasslands across Kaziranga National Park, in quiet dignity, flanked by the south bank of the mighty Brahmaputra on one side and densely forested hills on the other.

Robust as a raw diamond, this majestic creature had been mercilessly hunted down for its hide and horn for decades, until a protected area, northwest of Guwahati, was curated for its conservation a few decades ago. Over the last century and a quarter, this gentle beast has grown in number from 200 in 1904 to nearly 2000 at last count.

Kaziranga was declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1985 and today, its three ranges are home to more than 75% of the world's one-horned rhino population.

Full-bodied Assam tea is famous across the world for its quality and the plantations it comes from. Along a refreshing mountainous landscape, enchanting tea gardens sprawl green and luscious on both sides of the Brahmaputra. Set time aside for a leisurely visit.



The world's largest river island sparkles three hours away at **Majuli**. Vying for UNESCO World Heritage Site status, it is unique for its Hindu monasteries, dance and drama performances. For a memorable afternoon, visit Auniati Monastery, followed by a traditional Mising tribal lunch in a stilted bamboo hut, rounded off with a dance performance at Kamalabari Monastery.

While this stately beast is ample inspiration to millions of nature lovers the world over, Kaziranga's lushness lodges an impressive ensemble of other wildlife too. A host of birds including the crested serpent eagle, pelicans, Bengal floricans and black-necked storks; wild buffalo and boar, sambar; and the endangered barasingha, celebrated for its antlers, keep the enthusiast perked and shutterbugs zipping.

But the rhinoceros is not the only regal presence here. Safe from inhuman temptation, Kaziranga's thick forests boast of the highest density in tigers. With over 100 of them, averaging one per 5 km of sanctuary cover, guess who's really watching!

Sun-kissed peaks of brilliant white, gold and green... The valleys alight high passions true; and in a trice, the spirit is free – **fire in ice!**



In the heart of the heavenly Himalayas, lies a mesmerising beauty, unblemished and rare. With crystal clear rivers gushing down steep icy slopes flanked by colours in all hues of topaz and green, Sikkim is a serene ode to creation.

Rich in culture, it has a calm and pervasive spiritual tone that homes a composed Buddhist sentimentality as gently as it fires the adventurous appetite for brave highland pursuits. All along, the Kanchenjunga watches over, magnificent, like a solitaire – fiery and inspiring, icy and calm.

With a stunning 360° panorama, **Chakung** is 45 minutes away from Baiguney. From 6,000 ft high, view the Rangeet valley on one side and Mt. Kanchenjunga on the other.

Here, the orients come together to enliven your body and soul. Head north and pump your muscle on treks and trails, fast river rafts and mountain biking or enjoy the melodic silences of wildlife sanctuaries.

The west adds an unruffled peace of monasteries and gurgling waterfalls while down south, rustic villages exude a quiet, refreshing candour that augments the colours of the east with flora and fauna, bringing you right into the middle of a fairytale.

With breathtaking views of mountain trails, engrossing vistas and mystic monasteries, Jorethang will invigorate your senses instantly.

For a natural high on river fronts, animal sounds and everything blissful, here is a perfect cut that you will cherish, until you return for more. Make it soon.



Meanwhile, **Pelling** will leave you gasping, not as much for breath as for what the eye beholds. Minutes away, the Pemayangste Monastery and the ancient and rustic Sanga-Choling Monastery make your holiday well worth it. Sacred to Buddhists and Hindus, Khecheopalri Lake glimmers peacefully in the woods, calming every restive soul. Going up 1250 m above sea level, Kalimpong affords splendid mountain views with worthy detours to the Kali Temple, Tibetan Monastery and Dr Graham's home.

The mythical lores of PhurTsa Chu flow by the banks of river Rangeet. Meet the pilgrims and take a dip in the hot spring or soak in the legend of the holy caves where Guru Padhmasambhava slayed a demon. Make a wish at his 135 ft statue in Samdrupdste.

On to **Jorethang**. At 1,700 ft above sea level, this bubbling town and gateway to Rinchonpong, sparkles with life in the January Maghey Mela. A definitive collage of local culture and village life, this is an experience that makes you ponder. Rejuvenate in the hot springs of healing and give into the powers of holy caves that alleviate your mind and body. On the same trail, the Akar Suspension Bridge and Sisney Temple leave you wanting little.

The land of extravagant paintings, divine dance, stunning architecture and ancient literature that lasts to this day, also comes with delightful revelations of a different nature. And while one's calming power will leave you feeling like a new person every day, the other's spiritual intensity will infuse new life into you, forever.

Temple town, **Rameswaram**, stands marvellous and imposing, in the middle of the Gulf of Mannar,

bridged to the Indian mainland by the Pamban Bridge, second longest in India, and shaped like a bow to allow maritime passage. Surrounded by coral reefs, this is the glorious place where Lord Ram is believed to have offered his gratitude to Lord Siva, on successfully rescuing Sita. The waters that washed away Ram's sins for killing Ravan and his entourage, have since, attracted millions of Hindu devotees in search of peace and redemption. For those of you who are more interested in culture and art,

the enigma besots most profoundly. Wade in the shallow waters of Olaikuda and its coral reefs, for a leisurely high with the sea gulls and flamingos, and stimulate your soul with Dhanushkodi's sublime sunsets.

A natural phenomenon, the Ram Sethu is a bridge made of rocks, mini islands, coral reefs and sandbanks, believed to have been built by Lord Ram, with the help of the monkey army of Lord Hanuman, to connect India to Sri Lanka, on their march to bring Sita back from captivity. The other belief takes us to Adam's legend, where Adam crossed this bridge to reach Adam's Peak in Sri Lanka. Hence, the name, Adam's Bridge.

Moving into cooler climes and far from the comforts of religion, four enchanting mountains hold new spiritual highs, 1,048 m above the sea, at **Yelagiri**. Hold your gut as you heave along the visual delights of 14 traditional villages studded along 14 hairpin bends coiling up the ghats, to the top of the hill. Each bend is named after Tamil luminaries like Paavendar, Bharathiyaar and Tiruvalluvar among others, where the lucky seventh bend, unfurls magnificent views of mountain slopes and luxuriant green canopies that shield them from the elements. Naturally, trekkers revel in the luxury of thick forest trails and clement weather. And when they come down talking of delicious smells, think of flowers and fruits like fig, jackfruit,

At the base of **Swamimalai Hill**, reach out to the sky at 4,338 m above sea level. For lighter trekking, a 3 km trail leads to a small peak that throws open a sensational panorama of the valley below.

The Nature Park next to **Punganoor Lake** delights with its variety of plant species, typical to a rocky terrain. For a wonderful family day out, enjoy the artificial waterfalls and musical fountain that dances with many lights. Boating enthusiasts can head to **Nilavoor Lake**, surrounded by pretty gardens on its banks. Don't miss the **Thambiran Lotus Pond** in Nilavoor village.

star fruit, blackberry, cashew nut and the local delight, *panneer pazham*. Their abundance also ensures that Tamil Nadu's best honey is available close at hand, with bees busy at work in the luscious wild and well-tended home farms across the region.

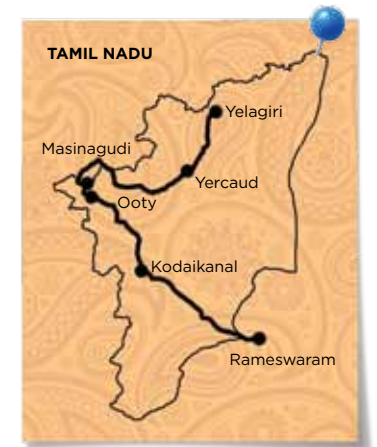
